### **Presenters**

Yosimar Reyes, Santa Clara County Poet Laureate (2024-25) is a nationally-acclaimed poet and public speaker renowned for his powerful performances and thought-provoking messages. Born in Guerrero, Mexico, and raised in Eastside San Jose, Reyes draws inspiration from his personal experiences as an immigrant and as a member of the LGBTQ+ community.

**Vinitha Watson** is the Co-Founder and Executive Director of **Zoo Labs**, a groundbreaking accelerator that bridges the worlds of art and business. Vinitha is an entrepreneur, design strategist, and artist (she is a trained Bharatanatyam dancer and Carnatic vocalist). Over the last twenty years, Vinitha has helped hundreds of artists, top level executives, and social impact teams heal, remove internal obstacles, and align themselves with their vision to grow impactful businesses globally.

Bosko Kante is an award-winning music producer, inventor, tech founder, and artist advocate. As one of the world's top talkbox artists, he has written and performed on Grammy-winning albums by Dua Lipa and Kanye West. Bosko, also a USC-trained Mechanical Engineer, invented the patented ElectroSpit mobile talkbox. In 2020, Bosko founded nonprofit HiiiWAV, a Black Music Incubator in Oakland. Bosko enjoys mentoring underrepresented creators to help them harness new technology, like AI and VR, in their art, build innovative business models, increase the social impact and reach of their work, and generate wealth for themselves, their families, and their community.

Maya Kante is a 5<sup>th</sup> generation Oakland native, Co-Founder & CMO of **ElectroSpit**, and VP of Strategy at **HiiiWAV**. She is a Business Strategist, a UC Berkeley grad, and a Certified Spiritual Life Coach who has led online, offline, and live-event marketing campaigns for lifestyle brands, top-selling beer and wine makers, and musical artists. She is passionate about creating jobs and training black youth in Oakland. Maya builds strategic partnerships, authentic brand messaging, and sales funnels that elevate the platforms of creative artist-entrepreneurs.
