- Character counts are a guide to maximum length, your answers may be shorter. You may use bullet points. On average there are 6 characters per word.
- Your answers will save automatically. Once you start an application you can return to it through your Applicant Dashboard (click the "home" icon at the top of the page) and click the "edit" link.

Eligibility Check

Review eligibility requirements and confirm eligibility below.

Applicant must:

- Be an artist in their 2nd-10th year of creative practice, post-student status (if applicable),
 with some track record of creating and presenting full work (not beginning artists), and
 artists who are NOT at a point in their careers where they receive consistent
 development and production opportunities and significant recognition, awards, and
 acclaim (not mid-career or established artists).
- Be at least 18 years of age at the time of the application deadline.
- Spend at least five-ten hours a week on and may derive income from the practice/creation of art.
- Have exhibited, performed, presented and/or published artistic work in a public context within the last three years.
- Be the principal creator/performer or the sole author of work(s) submitted.
- Be a resident of Santa Clara County or one of several bordering counties (Alameda, San Mateo, San Benito, and Santa Cruz Counties) for at least one year prior to the application deadline, AND can demonstrate through professional history that artistic activity has had an impact on residents of Santa Clara County.
- To be eligible for the South County Emerging Artist Award, artists must be presenting or performing their work in Gilory, Morgan Hill, or San Martin.

Applicant must NOT:

- Be enrolled as an undergraduate student.
- Be a prior recipient of the Content Emerging Artist Award or Artist Laureate Award from SVCREATES or Arts Council Silicon Valley.
- Be a current employee or board member of SVCREATES or have been employed by or served on the board of SVCREATES within the past 5 years.

Applicants would include artists creating work that is developed offstage, backstage, or pre-performance (choreographers, composers, stage directors, stage/set/costume designers). Or performers themselves (dancers, actors, spoken word artists, instrumental/vocal musicians).
- Literary Arts: all written literary art forms, including poetry, prose, stage or screenplay.

Narrative Questions

This section asks for a narrative discussion of your work. The next section requests work samples. These two sections should complement each other, strengthening the reviewer's understanding of your work. To avoid repetition, please review all four questions before completing your answers. The character limit is a maximum guide, your answers may be shorter. Strive to be clear and concise. Recommendations on the number of paragraphs for each answer have also been provided.

Artistic Practice*

Describe your current artistic practice. What mediums, subject areas, thematic focuses, aesthetic styles, forms or practices are you working with? What are you discovering in your work? What are your strengths?

If you work across disciplines, or in multiple disciplines, discuss how that impacts your creative practice.

Recommended length: 3-4 paragraphs.

Emerging Artist Career Stage*

In what ways do you consider yourself "emerging" as an artist or in your artistic practice? What are the areas you wish to devote more time and attention to to move your work forward? *Recommended length: 2-3 paragraphs*

Character Limit: 2500

Artistic Growth*

How do you continue to challenge, inspire and grow yourself as an artist? *Recommended length: 1-2 paragraphs*

Character Limit: 2000

Audience/Community Impact*

This award recognizes artistic merit, commitment to craft, AND a commitment to embracing a role as part of a larger community of artists and citizens, with specific engagement with audiences/communities in Santa Clara County.

Who are the specific social or artistic communities/participants/audiences you seek to engage/inspire/impact through your work? What is your connection to these communities and what is your desired impact? If you are applying for the South County award, specifically describe your impact in the Gilroy/Morgan Hill/San Martin area.

- Why should this artist be recognized as a Content Emerging Artist?
